The City of Blountstown will receive sealed bids from any qualified person, company or corporation interested in constructing the:

BLOUNTSTOWN FEMA PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE PROJECT

This project shall consist of repairs to a location around the City of Blountstown to address damage from Hurricane Michael. Repairs will include replacing a wooden pedestrian bridge.

Bids will be received until **Tuesday, November 5, 2024 at 10:00 AM CST** at the City Manager’s Office in the Blountstown City Hall, 20591 Central Avenue West, Blountstown, FL 32424, and will be opened and read aloud on **Tuesday, November 5, 2024 at 10:05 AM CST**. The bid will be awarded to the lowest responsive bidder at the City Council Meeting on November 12, 2024.
